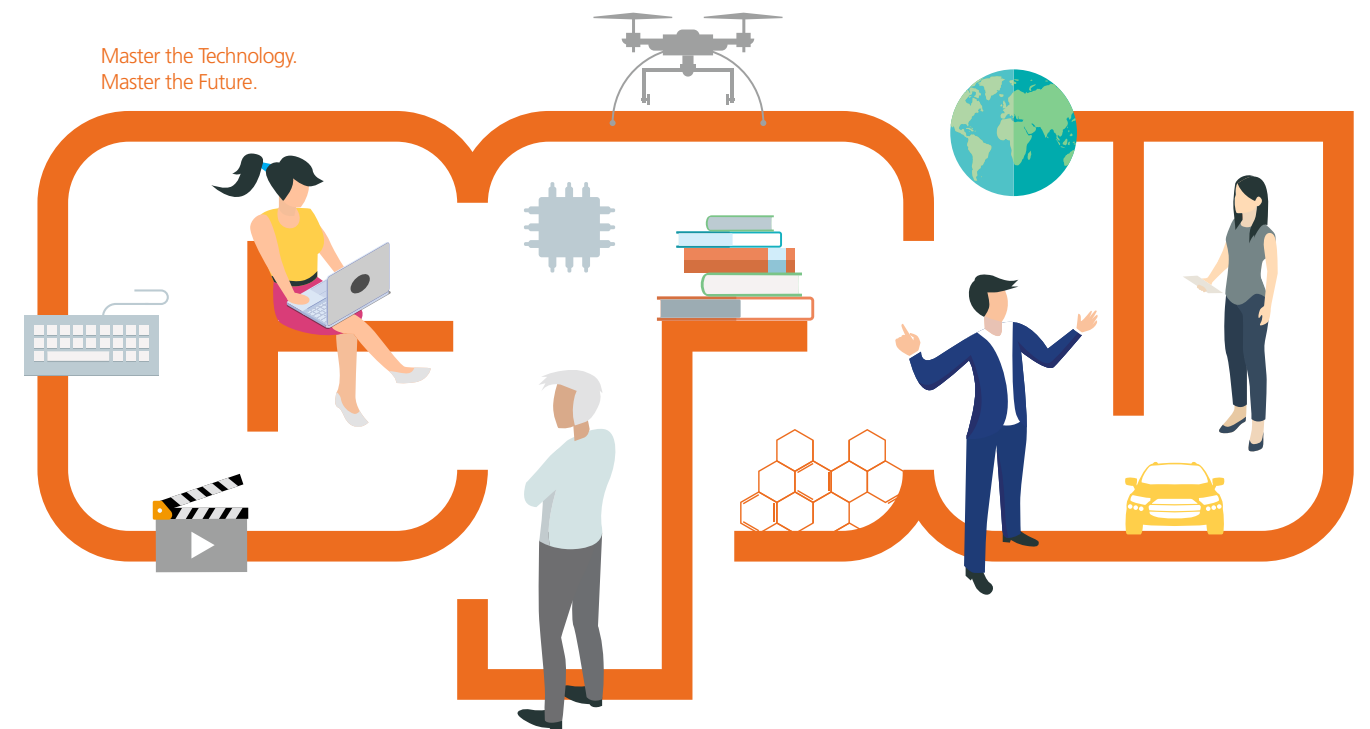

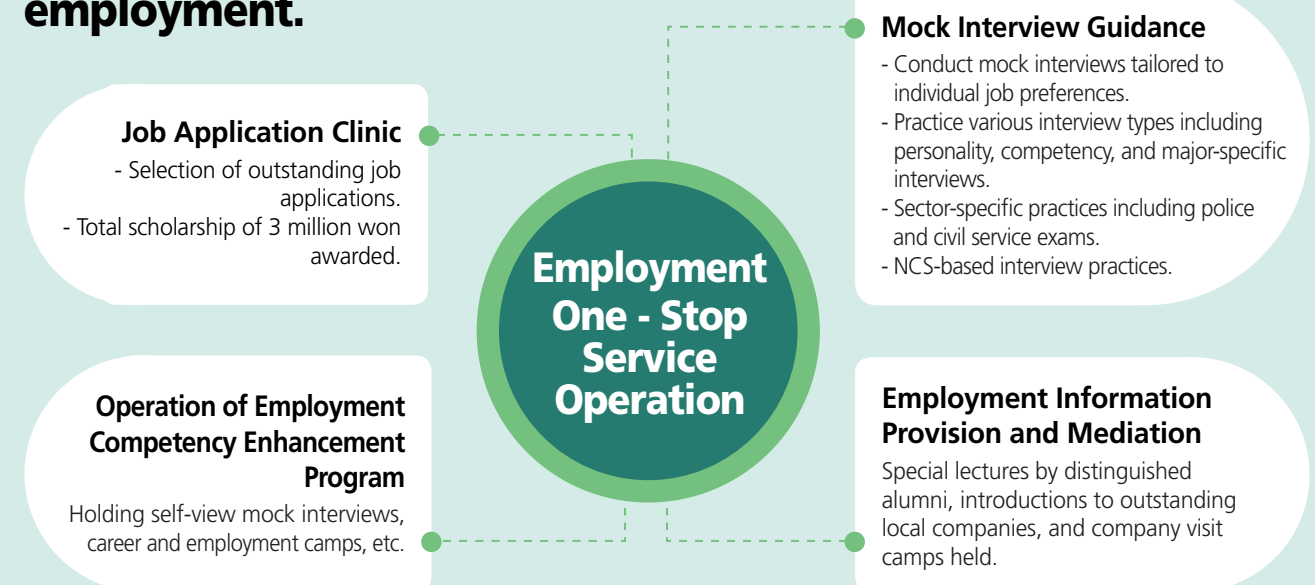

- ▶ "Access the university website (www.cpu.ac.kr) ⇒ Click 'Admissions' at the top center ⇒ Click on 'Early Admission, Regular Admission', 'Admission Schedule and Application Method' ⇒ Select one of the two application service banners and follow the instructions to fill out the application form (enter information) and save ⇒ Pay the application service fee ⇒ Print and confirm the examination slip ⇒ **Application complete**."
- ▶ Unlike visit or postal applications, online applications are subject to a service fee of 5,000 KRW by the internet application service provider, whereas the **university does not charge any admission processing fee** for the application itself.

● Scope of Permitting Multiple Applications

- ▶ During the Regular Admission Period (Autonomous University Recruitment): Multiple applications between junior colleges or between junior colleges and universities (including colleges of education and industrial universities) are possible, including within the same university.

● Prohibition of Multiple Applications

- ▶ Those who are accepted into any university (including industrial and educational colleges and junior colleges) during the early admission process, whether they register or not, are prohibited from applying for the regular and additional admissions.
- ▶ Those accepted into a junior college during the early admission cannot apply in other recruitment periods at universities (including colleges of education and industrial universities), and vice versa.

● Dual Enrollment

- ▶ Individuals who are accepted into two or more universities (including industrial, educational, and junior colleges) for the same semester must register at only one university.

● Registration of Early Admission Successful Candidates

- ▶ Those who are accepted during the early admission must register during the designated registration period; those with multiple early admissions must register at only one university, including any waitlisted institutions.
※ Deposits made are treated as official registration, and “registration” here means the submission of documents or payment of a registration deposit.
- ▶ Note that pre-registration before the official registration period is prohibited.

● Forfeiture of Registration and Tuition Refund

- ▶ The forfeiture of registration and the corresponding tuition refund for those accepted into more than one institution where multiple applications are allowed will be handled according to the “University Tuition Fee Regulations.”

● Filling Seats with Unregistered Candidates

- ▶ If vacancies occur during a recruitment period, selection can be carried over to other recruitment periods, and those who refund their tuition during the selection period can also be selected for enrollment.

● Actions Against Violations of Multiple Applications and Dual Registration

- ▶ After the end of the selection process, all university freshmen's application, acceptance, and registration status will be computer-checked. If prohibited multiple applications or dual registrations are confirmed, admission will be invalidated.
- ▶ The prohibition principle of multiple applications and dual registration does not apply between [junior colleges (and universities, including industrial and educational colleges)] and [universities and various schools established by special laws].
※ Exceptions to the prohibition of multiple applications and dual registration include: Army, Navy, and Air Force Academies, Police University, Korea Polytechnic Universities, Korea National Open University, Korea National University of Arts, Korean Traditional Culture School, Korea National College of Agriculture, etc.

● If an applicant intentionally misrepresents the acceptance status on the application form, it constitutes a violation of the application procedures, which may later lead to cancellation of admission.

● If it is confirmed that an applicant has gained acceptance or admission through fraudulent means, even after enrollment, the acceptance or admission may be invalidated.

● During the waitlist announcement period for both early and regular admissions, candidates who receive waitlist acceptance notifications from other universities must immediately convey their intention to forfeit registration for the universities they do not wish to register with.

※ Unlike general universities, junior colleges do not have a limit of 6 applications for early admissions.

12 Tuition Refund Process and Required Documents

- ▶ Refunds of tuition fees after registration at the university, such as for those who gain admission to another university or decide against pursuing higher education, are allowed only if the "Tuition Refund Application" is submitted. According to the Ministry of Education's "Regulations on University Tuition," a full refund of the tuition paid will be granted if the application for refund is completed by the day before the entrance date.
- ▶ To apply for a refund, access the university's website (www.cpu.ac.kr), navigate to 'Admissions Information' at the top center ⇨ 'Admissions Schedule and Application Methods' ⇨ 'Withdrawal and Tuition Refund Information.' Required documents for in-person submission include: 1) Tuition Refund Application (downloadable from the university website), 2) Receipt of Tuition Payment, 3) Applicant and guardian's seal, 4) A copy of the bank account for receiving the refund. All required documents must be submitted to initiate the refund process, which typically takes 7 days from the date of receipt.
- ▶ If it is difficult to proceed as above due to personal circumstances, download the "Tuition Refund Application" from the university website, prepare documents 2) and 4), and send them via fax to the Office of Academic Affairs. It is crucial to verify the receipt of the fax, as the refund process begins only after confirmation.

● Residence Hall Admission Procedures

- ▶ **Announcements and applications are taken in February and August** each year, considering the admission period, and dormitory fees are paid into a designated account, with payment made under the student's name.
- ▶ If the number of applicants exceeds the capacity, selection is made considering priorities such as first-year students, long-distance residing students, academically excellent students, and special scholarship recipients. The selection results are announced on the student residence hall website.
- ▶ If a refund is desired due to acceptance at another university, a separate dormitory fee refund application must be made before the start date of the residence period for a full refund.
- ▶ **Residence periods in the student housing are divided into the first semester, summer vacation, second semester, and winter vacation.** Applications for each period must be made separately according to the respective announcement schedules for each semester and vacation period. Upon the end of the semester, students should return home according to the check-out schedule. Basic furniture (desk, chair, bed, etc.) is provided in the student residence hall, but **personal items (toiletries, bedding, laptop, etc.) should be prepared by the residents upon admission.**
 - ※ **Cooking is not allowed in the residence hall;** however, microwaves may be used for simple cooking.
- ▶ If you must check out of the student residence hall, the refund amount will be processed according to the residence hall operation regulations based on the date of departure.
 - ※ Note: There is no separate student residence hall for the Osong Campus (Bio Life Sciences and Pharmaceuticals Department)

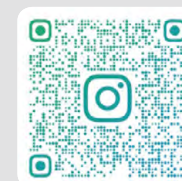
